The ETB Pathways Scholarship is a one-time award intended to be available to New Mexico's neediest students who have demonstrated academic excellence in high school. The ETB Pathways Scholarship is open to all graduating New Mexico high school seniors attending any public or private college or university in the United States.

Eligibility Requirements

All applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be a First Time Freshman
- Be a New Mexico high school graduate from any public or private high school
- High School graduating GPA of 3.5 on 4.0 scale
- Have filed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and have a \$0 Estimated Family Contribution on your Student Aid Report (SAR)
