Critical Consideration	Criteria: Met, Not Met or N/A
Strategy for limiting in-person staffing to essential in-person functions	Limiting occupancy to a maximum of 25%, managing foot traffic flow, ensuring social distancing of at least six feet, and required face coverings
Strategy for rapid response testing	Identified partnership with local, regional, or statewide medical provider
Strategy for contact tracing	On-campus point of contact for New Mexico Department of Health contact tracers support
Strategy for screening students, faculty and staff	Established protocols that consider regular temperature checks, questionnaires on symptoms and travel, and service by appointment
Strategy for limiting campus visitors	Established protocols for managing indoor/outdoor traffic flow
Strategy for screening campus visitors	Established protocols that consider regular temperature checks, questionnaires on symptoms and travel, and service by appointment
Protocols for cleaning and disinfecting	Established protocols for daily/regular cleaning of public and shared spaces
Protocols for minimizing exposure in classrooms	Managing occupancy and foot traffic flow, ensuring social distancing of at least six feet, and required face coverings
Protocols for minimizing exposure in labs	Managing occupancy and foot traffic flow, ensuring social distancing of at least six feet, and required face coverings
Protocols for minimizing exposure in other campus facilities	Managing occupancy and foot traffic flow, ensuring social distancing of at least six feet, and required face coverings
Protocols for minimizing exposure in residence halls	No double occupancy, cleaning protocols, identified isolation space, ensuring social distancing of at least six feet, and required face coverings
Protocols for safely opening campus dining	No indoor dining and no self-service
